JOB DESCRIPTION

The Employee shall perform the duties and exercise powers consistent with health, safety and welfare on a construction site. This is a project site-based role and will involve the majority of the day on the site, enforcing, educating and encouraging safe working practices. The duties shall include but not limited to the following:

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Preparation of Health and Safety policies, regulations, and risk assessments to minimize injuries and accidents on construction site.
- Responsible for all health, safety and environmental aspects (in worksite).
- Undertake site audits and site inspections.
- Training Staff, keeping HSE records.
- Investigate accidents and identifies causes.
- Acting as the site's point of contact for any H&S enquires as well as any emergency services events.
- Checking compliance with legislation and working with the site team to promote the safe conduct of work in general.
- Make recommendations concerning the modification, improvement, or removal of any company equipment, facilities, or machinery that is hazardous to employee safety or health.
- Provide safety induction trainings for any contractor or others that will be on site.
- Conduct daily safety audits and inspections to ensure compliance with government regulations.
- Good knowledge of all actions of the Emergency Plans under the instructions of the Security and Safety Manager.
- Attending to project weekly progress meetings.
- Conducted activity planning meetings with subcontractors prior every work to be executed.
- Writing method statements and risk assessments for the jobs to be done.
- Undertake other project specific tasks and responsibilities if needed.

- At least 10 years of proven working experience in construction and minimum of 5 years in a H&S
